

Inter-Neighborhood Cooperation, Denver's association of delegates from active Registered Neighborhood Organizations throughout Denver, took an emergency action regarding Council Bill 16-0306. This action included members of our board of directors attending your council meeting on 05/31/2016 and hearing the input from the knowledgeable city representatives.
