Denver INC is a voluntary, non-profit coalition of representatives from approximately 150 of Denver's Registered Neighborhood Organizations (RNOs) and associate members from city agencies and businesses.

INC's mission is to advocate for Denver citizens by bringing together, informing and empowering neighborhood organizations to actively engage in addressing City issues such as zoning, planning, transportation, education, parks and recreation, and public safety.

INC was established in 1975, operates as a not-for-profit organization and is managed by volunteers. It is also classified as a public charity under the 509(a)(1) and 170(b)(1)(A)(vi) of the Internal Revenue Code. INC's 501(c)(3) Federal tax identification number is 84-0820113.
