Sidewalk Gap Program

- Building sidewalks where they are currently missing for more mobility continuity for our community.



Citywide Sidewalk Gap Program

WORKING WITHIN THE CITY

- Program has two funding sources:
 1. CIP (2017 \$2.5M, 2018 \$1.5M and anticipated \$2.5M 2019)
 2. Elevate Denver Bond (\$30.7M + \$17M= \$47.7M)
- CIP Money- addresses missing sidewalks along City owned property.
- Elevate Denver Bond- addresses Transit Gaps & GES neighborhood

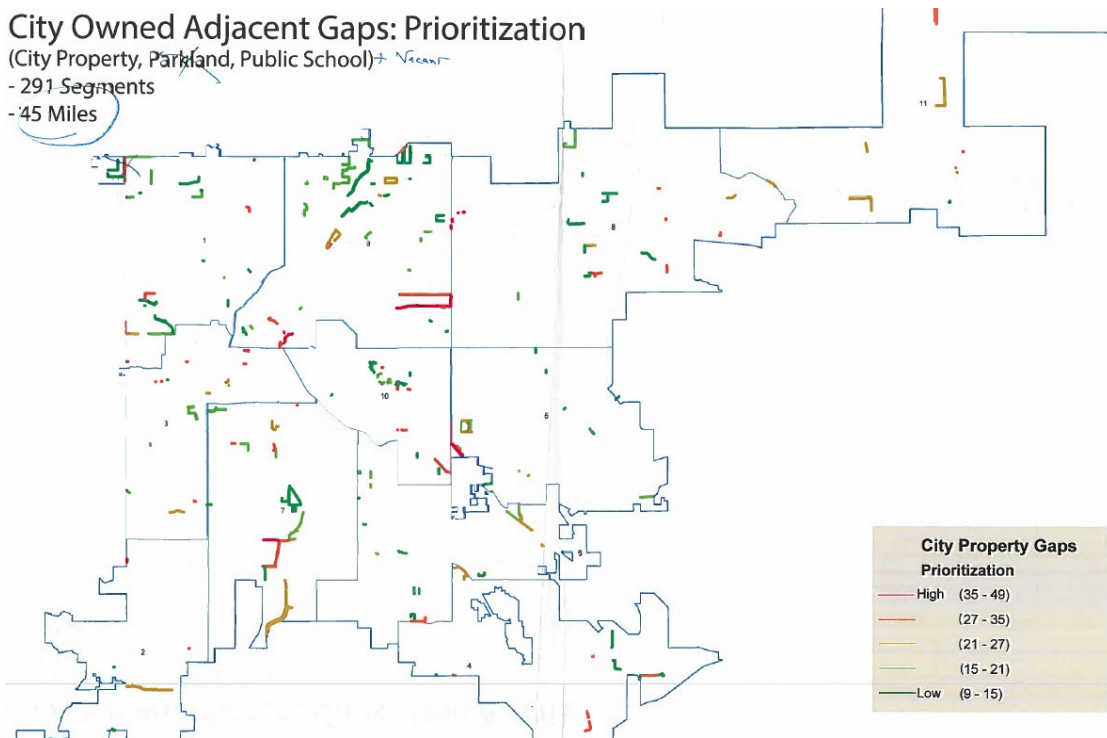
CIP Sidewalk Gap Program: How Prioritized

- City owned property
- High injury network
- Improving access to transit
- Access to schools, parks, grocery stores
- Areas with low income and high rates of childhood obesity

City Owned Adjacent Gaps: Prioritization

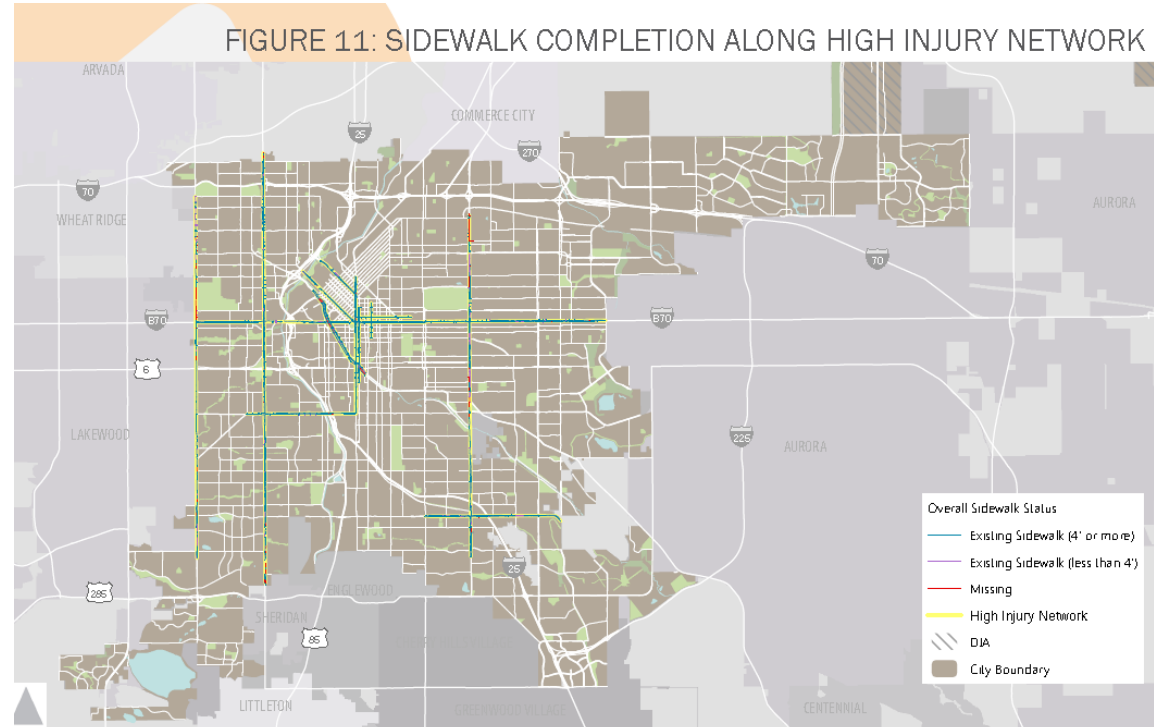
(City Property, Parkland, Public School) + Vicinity

- 291 Segments
- 45 Miles



CIP Sidewalk Gap Program: Map

- Over **355 miles** of sidewalk gaps identified in Denver Moves
- Sidewalk Gaps along City owned property – **45 miles**
- Completed or in progress- **3 miles** along City owned property in 2017/2018

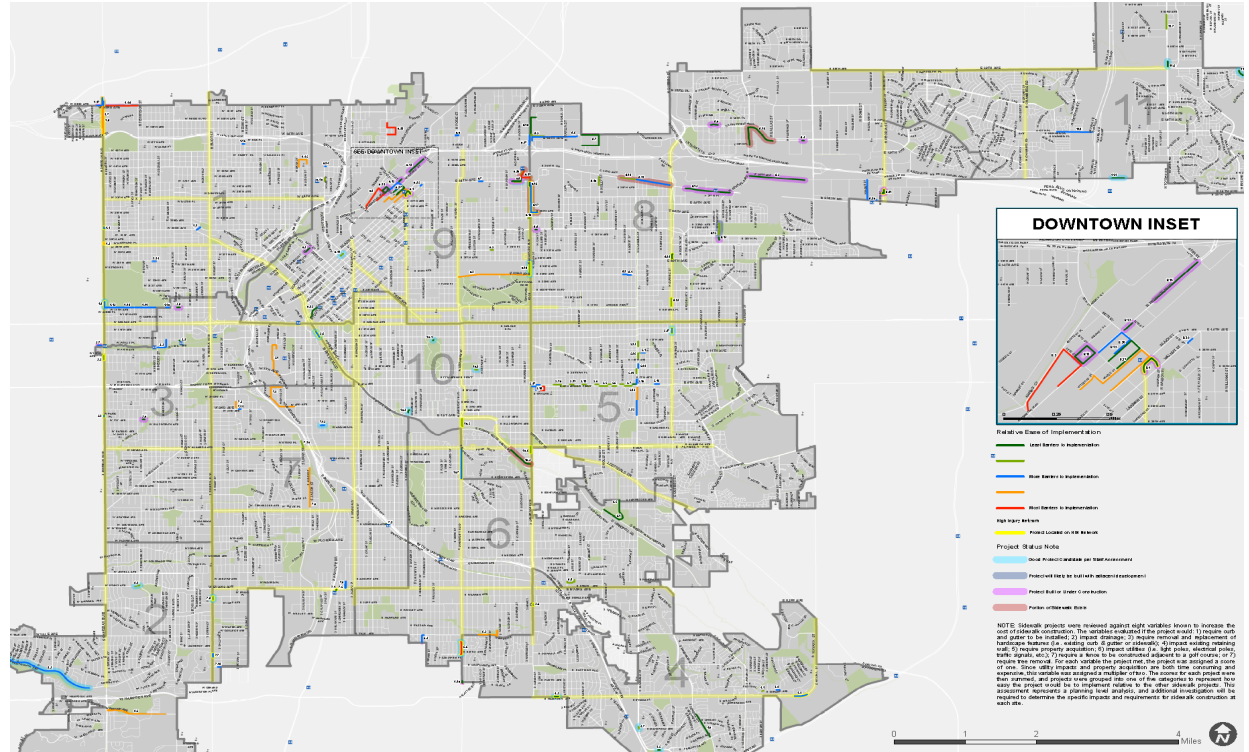
- Cramner Park (under construction)- Council District 5

Elevate Denver Bond Sidewalk Gap Program: Map

Elevate Denver GO Bond:

- \$30.7M for Sidewalks to Transit
- \$17M for the Globeville, Elyria, and Swansea neighborhoods

Prioritization based on criteria established in Denver Moves: Pedestrians and Trails.



Sidewalk Gap Program: Next Steps

What is happening with the gap program in 2018 & 2019?

- Continuing to work on assessment, design and construction of sidewalks along City owned property across all Council Districts
- Developing the Elevate Denver sidewalk gap program and first locations/timing
 - Finish Internal Assessment for updated list
 - External Assessment, prioritization and implementation strategy
 - Small package design
