



SOS Use Agreement

This Safe Outdoor Space (SOS) is a temporary project meant to mitigate the spread of the COVID-19 outbreak and better connect unhoused individuals with housing, healthcare and other resources. In order to promote a safe, healthy culture, residents are asked to uphold the following responsibilities.

Resident Responsibilities:

- **Complete intake form with Site Manager** upon moving into the SOS.
- **Positive interaction with fellow Residents, Staff and Volunteers** (a.k.a. treat others how you want to be treated).
- **Discuss housing plans and other resources** with outreach workers
- **Uphold Basic Guidelines:**
 - No Violence
 - No Weapons
 - No Substance Use/ Possession on site
 - No Trading/Selling Substances
 - No Theft
 - No Fires
 - No Guests due to COVID
 - No Disruptive Behavior - Obey quiet hours from 10 pm-6 am
 - No Discriminatory/Oppressive Behavior
 - Promote peace and wellbeing for all guests
- **Practice Social Distancing**, handwashing, wear a mask in common areas, and maintain 6ft of distance between self and others
- **Abide by Safer at Home orders** and only leave premises for Essential Activities
- **Agree to leave SOS and receive medical treatment** if displaying symptoms
- **Keep space clean** - All belongings must fit inside tent and/or storage bin
- **Keep permitted pets on a leash and clean up** after pets
- **Address conflict nonviolently**, staff is available to assist with conflict resolution.
- **Report violations** of agreements to staff
- **Agree to leave SOS once SOS closes** at the conclusion of the Public Health Emergency.
