

INC Youth Civic Engagement Grant Application

2024

Three \$500 and One \$1,000 Award

The Inter-Neighborhood Cooperation (INC) is inviting Denver-based youth groups that conduct civic engagement projects to apply for a grant to help fund those efforts. Three \$500 and one \$1000 award will be presented on March 11, 2024 for activities that will occur prior to June 30, 2024.

The intent of these awards is to help 14 to 19 year-olds recognize the importance of citizen involvement in their own community and how neighborhoods can be improved through their efforts. In other words, INC is planting seeds for Denver's future neighborhood leaders.

Diversity, Equity, & Inclusion focus: At least one grant will be reserved and awarded to a youth group in a Denver city designated Neighborhood Equity and Stabilization (NEST) community.

- 2. List the project's name, budget and other funders' contributions.
- 3. What Denver neighborhoods will be impacted by these activities?
- 4. When will the activity or activities take place and how many teens will participate?
- 5. Do you, or members of your group, reside in one of the following NEST neighborhoods: Athmar Park, Barnum, Barnum West, Clayton, College View, East Colfax, Elyria Swansea, Globeville, Kennedy, Lincoln Park, Mar Lee, Montbello, Ruby Hill, Sun Valley, Valverde, Villa Park, Westwood, and Windsor
- 6. If your grant application is approved how will the grant funds be used?
- 7. If your grant application is approved you will be asked to submit a project report and photos.
